Scouts visiting the laboratory from May through September will have an opportunity to go out on Hemlock Lake in the City's Environmental research vessel. Waivers required. One adult leader or parent must also attend. Limited to five Scouts per session and only conducted once per month from May through September.

Scouts without complete workbooks will be dismissed.

First Aid - Mr. Walker and Ms. Fox

- Mr. Walker: 1-MUST be 1st Class; 5-bring kit +printed worksheets
- Ms. Fox: 1-completed 1st Aid req. of T-2-1 ranks; 5-Bring first aid kit.

Scouts should have their Scoutmaster or Troop Advancement Coordinator sign off on their worksheet if requirement #1 is completed. This will be proof that T-2-1 (Tenderfoot, Second Class & First Class) First Aid skills in RANKS requirements were done. Additionally proof of First Class Rank can be properly uniformed First Class Scout. (Means they are wearing their earned First Class rank patch on the pocket.)

A new scout or any scout that has not done those requirements will not have the background skills to understand and perform the skills for the merit badge requirements we will be doing. They will not be allowed into the session.

<u>Additional comment from the Towpath Committee:</u> Review those T-2-1 First Aid skills and do some hands-on practice of them prior to coming to MBU helps you *Be Prepared*!

Scouts will have an opportunity to operate FRS handheld radios.
